Academic Exchange Agreement

The Institute of Korean Studies at Free University in Berlin, Germany, and the Institute of Korean Cultural Studies at Yeungnam University in Korea agree to conduct exchanges in accordance with the principle of reciprocity equality to promote mutual friendship and academic exchange.

1. Both institutes will cooperate on the following matters in accordance with the principle of reciprocity equality.
 - (1) Sharing academic investigations, research, and outcomes
 - (2) Exchange of academic information on academic materials, publications, research manpower, etc
 - (3) Academic projects such as co-hosting conferences, educational activities, and cultural events
 - (4) Other matters necessary for the development and friendship of both institutions
2. This Agreement is valid for three years and is automatically extended every three years. The revocation of the agreement shall be notified in writing three months in advance, and terminated by consultation between the two research institutes.
3. This Agreement shall be prepared in Korean and English in two copies each. and The agreement shall be effective from the date the directors of the two research institutes sign it.
